The purpose of this document is to:

1. Authorize the members of the SB-CISMA or its contractor(s) to enter or cross the private property at times agreeable to the landowner for identification, verification and treatment of targeted invasive species.
2. Members of the SB-CISMA will conduct treatment of targeted invasive Species using best management practices and will follow all applicable state regulations; these may include mechanical, chemical, or biological methods.
3. The landowner gives permission to the Saginaw Bay CISMA to apply for necessary permits on their behalf.
4. SB-CISMA, its agents, partners, and members agree to hold landowners harmless for all claims, suits or actions whatsoever resulting from this cooperative agreement and to absolve landowners from all liabilities related to actions conducted by SB-CISMA. Likewise, the landowner agrees to hold SB-CISMA, its agents, partners and members harmless for all claims, suits or actions whatsoever resulting from this cooperative agreement.
5. The landowner agrees to observe, monitor and manage regrowth of invasive species specified in this document without further assistance by the CISMA, unless otherwise noted by written document.
6. The landowner grants permission for a period of time to be determined in cooperation with the SB-CISMA for up to five years or until formally revoked, either orally or in writing. Permission is also granted for projects monitoring by SB-CISMA and its agents.
7. This agreement shall be effective upon the signature of all the parties listed below.
